### Kleenheat Community Grants program returns for 2023.

After a successful 2022 program, applications for the next round of Kleenheat Community Grants are now open.

Grants of up to \$1000 are on offer to community groups and not-for-profit organisations throughout the Northern Territory.

Kleenheat's Community Grants are provided across these five categories:

- **Connected Communities** – growing stronger community relationships through activities that bring us all together.
- **Inspiring Bright Minds** – helping our big-thinkers turn bright ideas into positive change.
- **Health + Wellbeing** – being proactive in championing the many benefits of a healthy mind and body.
- **A Healthy Planet** – getting behind groups and causes committed to protecting our environment.
- **Cultural Diversity** – understanding and celebrating the many cultures that enrich our community.

Kleenheat started its current Community Grants program in 2020 and has since awarded \$100,000 in grants to community organisations across regional Western Australia and the Northern Territory.

Kleenheat General Manager, Tanya Rybarczyk said Kleenheat is proud to have been operating in the Northern Territory for more than 35 years.

“We are a gas supplier servicing all regions across the territory. As a result, we get to see the exceptional work that community organisations do in the Northern Territory firsthand,” Ms. Rybarczyk said.

The grant helped it develop its early childhood program, and gave it more opportunities to connect with families through its interactive online platform and face-to-face playgroups.”

“Our grants program continues to make a big difference in local communities, and we encourage all eligible community groups from across the Northern Territory to apply.”

The grants are now open and will close on 24 September, with successful applicants to be announced at the end of October.
